Thank you once again for the grant of \$1440 in March 2014. James Hoskins and I have used the funds to help support the "Glendi at the Schoolhouse" potluck, music and dance series, held in the historic Salina Schoolhouse in Four Mile Canyon. Glendi is a Greek word meaning "party" or "festivity." As of November 2015, we have held 12 Glendis (generally on the first Wednesday of the month) since receiving the funds. As hoped, we have attracted folkdancers and neighbors, averaging 16 paying attendees (estimate based on the requested donation of \$10 at the door; there were often a few nonpayers). The Glendis are popular with the musicians too, and we always have at least four. As stated to the patrons, half of the door receipts are donated to

the Salina Schoolhouse to help pay for repairs after the 2013 flood.

As you can see, the AWLFund grant covered the losses of the Glendi series almost entirely! We plan to continue the Glendis, so please come and join us often.
